If yes, please explain:

Inspectors issued 34 "Notice of Violations" and 6 "Corrective Action Orders." The violations were issued for standard soil erosion infractions (lack of erosion controls like silt sacks or silt fence, or for offsite tracking). Corrective Action Orders are for when they fail to address notice of violations in a timely fashion or if the initial violation is egregious. No instances of violations with any direct discharges to waters of the state occurred.

Specific records for violations are kept with ESD staff and available upon request.

### Illicit Discharges

How many illicit discharges were detected in 2022? Nine

Explain each illicit discharge and action taken to investigate/clean up each discharge:

Beacon Recycling – 650 Chestnut Ave SW

Various contaminant sources were noted to go to our stormwater system on May 12, 2022. All of these have been addressed and our storm lines were cleaned to remove all of the residue.

Michigan Milk Producers – 1020 Hall Street SW

On September 20, 2022, our Industrial Pretreatment staff informed me that they had noticed a white milky substance in our storm drains. They were able to track it from the manhole just before the outlet to Plaster Creek to a catch basin in the 1020 Hall St parking lot. Sewer maintenance was contacted to

plug the outfall while we contacted the company to determine what the substance was. Michigan Milk Producers informed us that the substance was 40 gallons from a damaged crate of milk containers. Sewer maintenance then vacuumed the milk from the manhole near the creek.

Thierica – 843 Matilda NE

On December 9, 2022, one of our inspectors noticed green liquid going to a catch basin. Later, we were also sent a PEAS notice on the spill. The water was noted to be from a paint spray booth that leaked and spilled out of the door. A cleanup company was called and Tierica was charged for their and our services.

All of these sites had cross connections identified while televising our storm sewers. All of the cross connections were re-routed by November of 2022.

## Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control (Part 91)

Were there any changes made to your SESC program in 2022? (ex. change in Part 91 status as an APA or MEA)

No significant changes were made to the SESC program. Overall, 2,613 soil erosion inspections were completed by 3 full time inspectors. The inspectors are certified as construction stormwater operators and have soil erosion plan review and design certifications. There were a total of 680 Plan reviews completed with 129 Land Use Development Permits (LUDS) SESC permits issued.

Were there any issues identified in 2022 under the SESC program on construction sites under your jurisdiction? If so, please explain:

There were no SESC program related issues noted in 2022. As mentioned previously, violations and citations were issued to contractors and projects for standard construction related issues.

## Post Construction Control (Development and Redevelopment)

How many developments were approved under the new stormwater ordinance?

A total of 19 projects were reviewed in 2022 under the new standards following the implantation of the new code on August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Of those 19 projects, 9 have been approved, 8 are still in the review process, and 2 of those projects have been withdrawn due to economic market conditions.

Were any maintenance agreements signed?

Maintenance agreements are required prior to project closeout. Projects requiring maintenance agreements post 2022 code implementation have not been completed yet.

How are you tracking signed maintenance agreement requirements?

Maintenance agreements are required prior to project closeout, tracked through our standard permit documentation program “acela” and then are recorded with the County.

Yes, 6,6435 tons of street sweeping residuals were disposed of in 2022. Major Streets were swept five times and local streets were swept three times.

Yes, the City utilizes the following practices: de-icing, pre-wetting, truck calibration, and street prioritization. They are also piloting temperature sensors in some streets and are looking ot order trucks with GIS tracking of salt usage.

Yes, we have a commercial car wash connected to sanitary sewer.

## Industrial Program

Industrial inspections: The program started in late August of 2022. 109 surveys were required, 97 were returned and 24 inspections were completed. Inspection letters were not issued in 2022 due to software issues.
