# Ottawa County Soil Erosion & Sedimentation Control

## ILLCIT DISCHARGE INSPECTION REPORT

Date of complaint: 9/8/2023

Caller: Dave

Location of Discharge: Pollution Source was GR Hide Co. at 5501 40th Ave, Hudsonville, MI 49426 into Hudsonville Storm Sewer. This storm sewer outlets into a roadside ditch and then into Blacklock Drain a tributary to nearby Rush Creek.

Site Condition: Arrived on site around 4:30 where the Blacklock Drain flows into Rush Creek, this is the original location given. The water flowing into Rush Creek from Blacklock was noticeably dark. Following upstream the outlet from Hudsonville's storm sewer was brown and had a sewage/rotten smell, there was foam on the surface and what appeared to be tissue paper. Following upstream checking catch basins, I determined the illicit discharge was entering just South of VanBuren on 40<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Recommendations: Hudsonville BPW was called to help identify if a sewer leak had occurred. We also called Randy Meyer Excavating and they set out core logs to help prevent pollutants from going downstream.

Response:

- 9/8/2023: I left at 6:30 and at around 7 Hudsonville BPW and Joe Bush identified the pollution source as GR Hide. They were contacted and promptly stopped any pollutants from entering the drain in their shop.
- A few days later (appx. 9/11) plumbers trucks were seen on site. I spoke with Bob Miller who said they are working on rerouting the drain to sanitary.
- 9/18/2023: Through email Kevin Austin, Georgetown Zoning Administrator, notified us that the work rerouting the drain to sanitary was complete on 9/15/2023 and inspected by their plumbing inspectors from PCI.

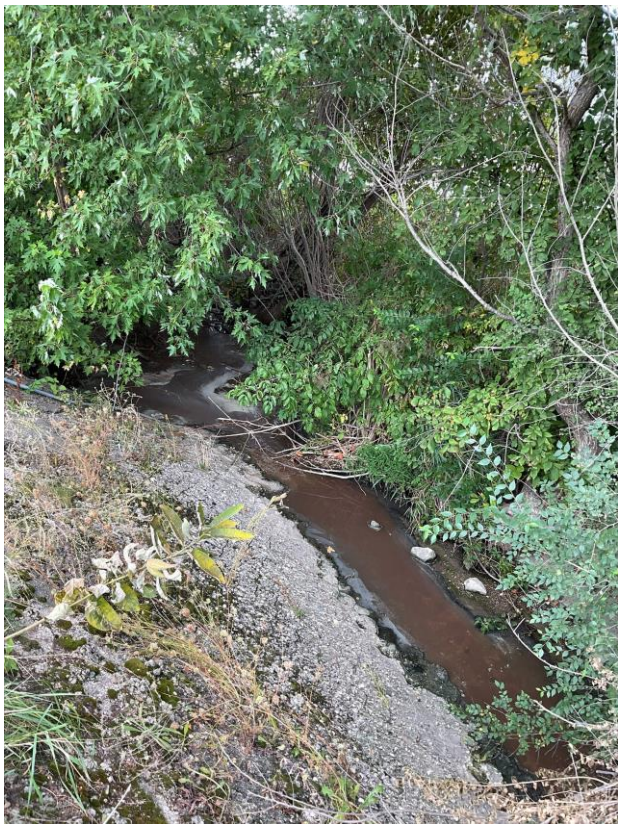
