### Phase 1 Self, Family, & Team

Creating supportive parent teams, setting goals and establishing plans.

Fifty percent of Phase 1 participants go on to Phase 2 within 6 months.

# **Phase 2**Community Outreach

& Action

Creating communitybased agendas that start with common concerns raised by parents.

Sixty percent of Phase 2 participants go on to Phase 3 within 12 months. Phase 3
