1. Welcome and Introductions

2. LGROW Update

- a. a. SWOrd
 - i. Working on maintenance plans for developers to assess their projects to see if they are meeting requirements.
 - ii. Influential on getting the MS4 permits through, useful for communities to learn from one another for their own permits.

b. Subwatershed

- i. Made up of representatives from the 32 subwatershed groups (not all active),
- ii. watershed Jamboree to be hosted on September 17th at the Refugee Church in Grandville.

c. c. Public Engagement


- i. involved in the public implementation plan as part of the MS4 permits

d. d. Sustainability

- i. Working with urban farmers in the City of Grand Rapids
- ii. Working with Conservation Districts with Ag practices
- iii. Working with LGROW to implement the LGR Water Trail

3. TMDL Sampling

- a. Only 3 sampling dates in the past three months. Hopefully there will be more rain!
 - i. E. coli has an eight hour hold time this limiting the period in which can be done
 - ii. Qualifying rainfall is a .25 inch rain event with more on the way



- b. 2024 will be both dry and wet sampling. This will help to establish a baseline of what on a normal day is entering local river as to what is entering under rainy conditions
- c. Budget
 - i. P&N has spent roughly 400 dollars of their 3,000-dollar budget
- 4. EGLE Biological and Sediment Chemistry Report
 - a. Grand River was monitored in 2019
 - b. 35 sites in the Lower Grand River Watershed
 - c. Several sites ranked poor either from Macros or fish community
 - d. Several sites ranked Excellent, Prairie Creek, IMC, Section of the Lower Grand
 - e. EGLE will resample sites in Mill Creek
 - f. Will continue to sample sites along plaster creek, namely along Shady Side where much work has been done
