#### Minutes

1. Welcome and Introductions

a. Last meeting was Feb. 12 at the Kent County Recycling Center

#### 2. LGROW Update

- a. MS4 Permits
  - i. Grand Rapids Township Public Notice period: June 16-July 15
  - ii. Cascade Township Public Notice period anticipated before the end of the month
    - Kent Co. Township permits (Plainfield incl. anticipated soon), no comments expected

### b. Committee Updates

- Sustainability Committee- RCPP grant moving along, Kent Cons. District- hired a farmer full time and now have grant money (319) for more outreach. LGROW submitted for a grant to fund the Water Trail. Not meeting again until September. Grand River Expedition is postponed until 2021.
- ii. Public Ed.- giveaways are ready for pickup at GVMC
- iii. Subwatershed- Buck Creek cleanup Aug 18.
- iv. SWOrd- will have meeting on June 29, Cara to send out details

#### 3. TMDL Manual Review

- a. Comments received from MS4s were included before last meeting
- b. EGLE expectations and BMP implementation were discussed at the last meeting
- c. EGLE didn't give us great recommendations or a direction forward. But how do we do this without funding, and with limited resources
- d. Need to add info about how to prioritize sewersheds and BMPs (look at Rouge River)

- Need data to determine this. Can add more info about prioritization after data is collected
- e. Cara needs to edit and then send to EGLE to get feedback
  - Right now the plan specifies taking samples during wet weather events.
    However, EGLE didn't clarify that samples actually had to be taken during wet events. Cara will follow up.
    - 1. Confirmed 6.23.2020- samples must be taken in wet weather per C. Alwin, EGLE
  - ii. LGROW will add information about how we will prioritize areas in the future after sampling into the TMDL Implementation Plan
- f. TMDL on unnamed trib- pumped down 2010-2018 through the unnamed trib, but now it is trucked offsite and discharged into the Grand River (Knapp's Corner discussion)
- 4. What kind of support does your community need from LGROW right now?
  - a. Progress Reports- won't be due until 2021 so no reporting this summer
  - b. Missing prime public outreach period- is there anything else we can do?
  - c. Need training support
- 5. Lower Grand River Watershed Resilience Plan
  - a. What kind of related plans already exist in your community?
    - i. Wyoming, Walker, KCDC- nothing
    - ii. GR already captured
    - iii. If you want to review this plan, let Cara know
- 6. Upcoming Events
  - a. Sampling events?
    - i. No need to sample now for TMDL- need to complete all samples by Oct. 1 2023we could skip this season, need to determine wet or dry samples first
    - ii. Regular sampling still occurring- Buck Creek, River Run
  - b. Training Opportunities
    - i. P2GH Training Video
      - 1. Wyoming watched the training video, thought it was good
      - 2. Cara will send this video out with the supplemental guidance, and will also send a recording of the MWEA presentation with LimnoTech about TMDL work for everyone to see
    - ii. It would be helpful for communities if Cara reminded them about training requirements a month or so before progress report forms are due
  - c. Next Technical Meeting Aug. 19, meeting outdoors on GVMC's deck (virtual meeting as backup)
