Minutes

1. Welcome and Introductions

- b. Last meeting was Dec. 16, virtual
- 2. LGROW Update
 - a. MS4 Permits
 - b. Committee Updates
 - i. Public Ed- planning for the Forum, working on the new PEP reporting form
 - ii. Sustainability- meeting first week of March, working on outreach with students and farmers, addressing environmental injustice
 - iii. Subwatershed- working on grant applications

- 3. TMDL Manual Update
 - a. EGLE comments in December, discussion 2/11/21
 - Met with Christe Alwin, who was responsible for the EGLE comments to the draft
 - b. Review draft with comments
 - i. EGLE connecting TMDL plan to IDEP
 - 1. Need to do some E. coli monitoring during dry weather screening if there is flow
 - 2. Specify that extra dry weather sampling only applies to TMDL reaches.

- 3. If there is dry weather flow there needs to be an outline of what triggers the e. coli sample. Rachell: don't want to test city water when people are watering their lawns. Peter- people watering their lawns can be an issue bc people are pushing what is on their lawn down the drain (fertilizer, etc.)- this data was from EGLE. Rachell- this could be addressed from a public ed standpoint. A source that we would really like to solve is broken septic systems.
- 4. If ammonia and surfactants test pos.- in the high or immediate range, then return for e. coli test per the IDEP on the next follow up visit.
- 5. Add the prioritization for wet weather to make the same conditions apply to dry weather samples (sample sites for wet and dry weather-if flow present, are the same)
- ii. Need to justify taking 50 wet weather samples across the watershed
 - Add information regarding flow during 2018 dry weather screening at OFs (total # of OFs that actually had flow). EGLE's previous comment was wondering how many total OFs are in the watershed (a lot)
 - 2. Mention lack of resources
- iii. Need language from EGLE regarding wet weather conditions (what is a qualifying storm event?)
 - Will make our best attempt to capture wet weather samples during storm events, and will document the conditions when samples are taken
- iv. Timeline
 - 1. 2 wet weather sampling events proposed in 2022 and 2024- 2x is non-negotiable
 - 2. Need to get approval from Amanda, but IDEP would occur in 2024 during the second round of wet weather sampling
- c. Cara will revise, and resend to the Committee for review before forwarding on to EGLE for approval
