2. LGROW Update

- a. Sustainability Committee- lots of work on the Water Trail. Public outreach session to be held at GVSU Downtown on Feb. 23
- b. SWOrd- new version of the LGROW design spreadsheet available at: https://www.lgrow.org/ms4communities
- c. Public Outreach- LGROW giveaways are in and will be delivered to you soon
- 3. TMDL Sampling Selection
 - a. Review MS4 determined OF's that meet TMDL sampling location requirements
 - i. Review list of 50 sampling locations
 - 1. All locations meet the criteria specified in the TMDL plan
 - 2. We have 48 OF's identified, and most of them have been field verified
 - 3. Grand Rapids will add 2 OF's to be sampled, either on the Grand River, or on Plaster Creek to bring the watershed total to 50.
 - 4. LGROW can save a TSS and E. coli shapefile on REGIS for MS4s to access
 - b. Logistics of wet weather sampling
 - i. Prein&Newhof
 - 1. GVMC has hired P&N to do the collection and analysis of the Summer 2022 collection
 - a. We will need to help them up front with identifying a qualifying rain event, and potentially locating the outfalls

- We need to get a final list of OF's to P&N. Will also send them notes on specific locations if needed (how to find the OF if necessary). Will also provide MS4 contact information in case P&N gets questions from residents while in the field.
- 3. P&N will collect the samples and then provide us with the data
- 4. TMDL Report for MS4 Progress Reports
 - a. LGROW writing a draft TMDL report to add to the 2021 MS4 progress report- Cara will send out for Tech Committee to review
 - i. 2021 report will cover actions taken in Year 1 of the plan
 - b. Historical Data Collection
 - i. Josh has been analyzing data that was already collected in the watershed
 - ii. Is this data in a form that we can use in the report?
 - 1. Yes- graphs give us a good way to display the information that we already have. Can add future data once we have it
 - c. Committee can now focus on how will we use the data in the future
